

Camping- Personal Check List

Parents

The following items will be necessary to insure your child's health and comfort while participating in the activities planned for a camping trip. Please, NO radios, iPods, electronic games or other sound emitting electronic devices or; knives with blades longer than three (3) inches or requiring sheaths, Aerosol sprays, glass bottles or anything that has a high monetary or sentimental value. We have discovered that things have ways of being misplaced or broken on campouts!

All food and drink that your camper will need for the event will be provided (expect Friday evening snack/dinner) for a nominal fee decided upon by them and the other members of the unit.

ALL clothing items that your child takes should be permanently marked with their name. We frequently end up with a pile of dirty clothing after the campout with no one willing to claim anything in it. The following equipment, clothing, and personal items are recommended. However, if your child does not have a specific item, a substitution should be made to provide similar functionality. If you have any questions please talk with one of the leaders.

Equipment

- Pack
- Rain Jacket/Poncho
- Sleeping Bag
- Foam pad/air mattress
- Flashlight with new or extra batteries
- Personal First Aid kit
- Pocket knife (with totem chit)
- Pencil and Paper
- Boots or other rough soled shoes
- Scout Handbook
- Nalgene Bottle / Canteen
- Mess Kit (Knife- Fork- Spoon)
- Plate or Bowl
- Drinking Cup
- Pack cover or 2 large trash bags

Clothing

- Underwear (2 pair)
- Socks (3 pair)
- Sweater/ Fleece
- Extra Pants
- Hat (wool)
- Long Sleeve Shirt
- Extra pair of shoes (In camp)

Personal Hygiene

- Toilet paper in zip-lock bag
- Hand Sanitizer
- Soap in container
- Tooth brush Toothpaste
- Wash Cloth Hand Towel
- Comb or Brush
- Handkerchief(s) or tissues
- Lip Balm

Optional /Seasonal

- Sunglasses/Sunscreen
- Long Underwear
- Heavy Jacket Gloves
- Watch
- Camera
- Camp Chair
- Hiking stick
- Fire starter
- Insect Repellent
- Compass
